Correcting and praising your dog:

- Practice at home not at the park or outside of your house first.
- Correct your dog by saying "NO" (verbally) and using the leash (physically) if needed anytime your dog makes a mistake or when performs a behaviour that is unwanted.
- Praise your dog (verbally) by saying "good boy/girl and/or (physically) by petting.
- Try not to get emotional when correcting or praising your dog. Through repetition you will be able to find and practice the right state of mind.

How to correct and praise with your dog:

	If the dog makes a mistake:	If the dog does something good:
1. 2. 3. 4. 5.	Say "NO" (up to 3 times) in a firm but neutral tone. If ignored, put the dog on leash or hold the collar. Pull to a side and redirect the dog to you. Ask the dog to do something else or to calm down. Repeat if necessary.	 Reward your dog. Praise or play with your dog. Celebrate.
