9 Steps to take when teaching and training your dog.

- 1. For the next 10 days to 2 weeks, you need to be paying more attention to your dogs and correct and praise your dog as much as you can. Say "Rover NO", when your dog does something wrong. Say "Rover good boy/girl" when your dog does something good.
- 2. Train your dog inside your house, in the living room for the first few weeks or first month.
- 3. After a month or 45 days, start practicing on the hallway or in the back yard.
- 4. After 2 to 3 months, you are going to start practicing in the front yard or in front of your building.
- 5. 5 months after, you are going to practice on the streets.
- 6. After 6/7 months, you are going to start to practice in a low traffic park.
- 7. After 7/8 months, you are going to start practicing in a medium level traffic park.
- 8. After 8/9 months, you are going to practice in a high traffic park.
- 9. After 9/12 months, you are going to start practicing them in a fenced in, full of dogs, dog park.
