



Puppy Recall Command

For all the commands you need to remember this simple procedure:

1. Name of the dog (ONCE)
 2. Command (ONCE)
 3. Hand signal (ONCE)
- } **At the same time**

- Do not repeat them in any ways. Get used to saying once and making it happen.
- Make sure to make eye contact with your puppy when you call its name.

This command starts with the dog and stay.

1. Give the command of sit and stay,
2. Walk in front of your dog 4 to 6 feet away,
3. Say name of your puppy,
4. Give the command of "Come",
5. Sweep your right hand in front of your chest at the same time.
6. Restart this exercise and repeat steps 1 to 5 a few times from the same distance.
7. Increase distance as you get comfortable or confident about your puppy's level.

Additional forms of practicing recall:

- Encourage your dog to come to you.
- Use your soft voice, pat your legs or even back up to make your dog come to you.
- Make funny noises with your mouth.
- Tap your legs.
- Add toys for more added distractions or reward.
